

Using Lua^AT_EX to typeset RTL text with reledpar

Abstract

This file provides an example on how to use reledpar and Lua^AT_EX to typeset a right to left text with its translation on the facing page¹.

As you can see, the switch to RTL convention is made *before* the **pstart**. It must be also called inside **\eledsection**.
